

Pygora Goat Show (PBA Sanctioned)

Place: Allegan County Fairground, Fiber Goat Area

Times: Arrival must be at the fairgrounds between 12 Noon and 9 PM on Friday August 20th.

Show schedule will begin, Saturday, August 21th, at 10 AM.

Judge: Aaron Esterline from Vassar, MI

Release time is Sunday, August 22nd. at 4 PM. Early releases for those out of state exhibitors will be at the discretion of the Angora Goat Committee.

Entry Fees: \$8.00 per animal for animals brought for either show or sale. There will be no additional pen fee. Pen sizes are 4X6 and will accommodate 4 med. sized angora goats or approximately 6 kids comfortably. Exhibitors are encouraged to pen breeding bucks individually.

Pygora Show Rules:

1. All rules and regulations of the Pygora Goat Association will be enforced.
2. All goats must have an Original PBA Certificate of Registration to enter. This certificate must be available during check in and during the show.
3. All Pygora goats 1 year and older must be shown in fleece or with fleece in a box to be presented to judge. The fleece must be the current year's latest clip.
4. All group classes must be registered on the entry form. Group classes will not be accepted on the day of show.
5. PBA Show Rules will be provided upon request. Contact the show coordinator for more information.

1. Junior Wethers under one year
2. Senior Wethers 1-3 years
3. Senior Wethers over 3 years

Doe Class:

1. Junior Doe 0-6 months
2. Junior Does 6-12 months
3. Junior Does 12-24 months-Never Freshened (Kidded)

5. Senior Does 2-3 years

6. Senior Does 3-5 years

7. Senior Does over 5 years

8. Dam and Daughter-Looking for improvement in Daughter
9. Breeders Trio-Any 3 Does with same herd name
10. Get of Sire-2 Does, same Sire, different Dams
11. Judges Choice
